PRESIDENT "Irish" Keith Taylor

The President is the primary contact for any interclub or internal concerns. The President is also the key point of contact for Sponsors and Life Members and Government bodies.

The Vice President also is the Rugby Coordinator for the Club. The Rugby Coordinator will manage all fixtures, carnivals and competition issues involved with the club. The Rugby Coordinator, with the help of the Registrar, is the main point of contact for Coaches and Managers relating to games, rules, coaching and team management.

The Secretary looks after the administration tasks for the committee and the club. This includes the management of all communication, events, fundraising and merchandising. The secretary will support the President and Vice President in day to day running of the club.

The clubhouse manager reports to the treasurer to ensure the club is financially sustainable and fees are kept as low as possible for players
